As part of our commitment to reducing Scope 3 emissions, we partner with local spinners and dyers to ensure a lower-impact supply chain.

Our trusted suppliers are located just 30 miles from our factory on the outskirts of Greater Manchester. By sourcing locally we reduce transport emissions and support skilled craftmanship close to home, ensuring a more sustainable and responsible supply chain.

Fewer Emissions

We are committed to lowering our environmental impact by reducing energy consumption and improving efficiency across our facilities. Our factory and head office operate with energy-efficient lighting and heating systems, reducing our Scope 2 emissions from purchased electricity. We have also enhanced insulation to minimise heat loss, further cutting energy usage and reliance on external energy sources.

By manufacturing in Britain, we significantly reduce the emissions associated with long-distance transportation, helping to lower our Scope 3 carbon footprint. Keeping production close to home also allows us to maintain high-quality standards while supporting local industries.


Our factory operates with energy-efficient systems, reducing Scope 1 and Scope 2 emissions, ensuring a more responsible and sustainable approach to manufacturing. Choosing British-made means choosing lower emissions, higher quality and a commitment to contributing towards a healthier planet.





We're proud to have taken a significant step towards sustainability with our innovative secondary backing process. In 2008, we introduced the world's first 4-metre wide hot melt secondary backing line, making the switch from traditional latex to a more eco-friendly, solvent-free adhesive. This thermoplastic bonding agent is stronger and more sustainable, helping us reduce our environmental impact.

Our journey didn't stop there. In 2013, we took another important leap by adopting Evobac, a revolutionary recycled backing material made using post-consumer PET plastic. By replacing traditional Actionbac, Evobac recycles approximately 8 plastic bottles per square metre - to date we have prevented over 16 million plastic bottles from going to landfills or entering our oceans. Plus, our backing plant operates with greater energy efficiency, uses less water and features a cutting-edge computerised cutting table to reduce waste.



By implementing innovations like our solvent-free adhesive system and using Evobac, a recycled backing material made using post-consumer PET, we are helping reduce plastic waste and minimise our carbon footprint, therefore reducing our Scope 3 emissions.
